Goondicum is a 'living lab' located in the prehistoric Goondicum volcanic crater in Central QLD. CRATER has been granted access to the historic Goondicum Station east of Monto, a working cattle station which successfully implements the principles of regenerative agriculture in order to coexist in harmony with the land and its abundant native wildlife.

CRATER offers a unique location to study Australia's flora and fauna, natural sciences, and agriculture. We welcome scientists, researchers, agriculturalists and students from around the world, as well as nature enthusiasts. CRATER strives to promote the value of nature to human and animal health, and provides visitors with workshops, accommodation, and practical in-the-field experience.

FARMERS & GRAZIERS


CRATER hosts regular field days and workshops highlighting regenerative agriculture and restorative land management practices.
